DAY 1

(Breakfast on Board/Lunch/Dinner)

Upon arrival at Cape Town International Airport, depart for Boulders Beach to view one of the last African penguin habitats. Thereafter, drive to the world-renowned Cape of Good Hope, a historical landmark used by sailors to navigate the treacherous seas, where two oceans meet at Cape Point. The wine journey begins at the oldest winery in South Africa, Groot Constantia. Taste the wines and learn the historical significance behind them. Lunch will be served at Jonkershuis, one of Constantia's most popular restaurants, where traditional Cape Malay flavours meet modern classics on this 333 year old estate. What's left of the afternoon is spent at **Eagle's Nest**. The evening ends with a dinner at Societi Bistro, which serves an imaginative take on French/Italian cuisine.

DAY 2

(Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 2 begins with a trip up Table Mountain, one of the New 7 Wonders of Nature in a 360 degree revolving cable car, (Subject to Weather Conditions). Take in spectacular views of the City bowl, the 12 Apostles, and False Bay before descending and making your way to the trendy suburb of Woodstock. The NeighbourGood's Market, housed in an old biscuit mill, is a hive of activity where you will explore the sights and sounds of this bustling local produce market. Feast on Cape Town's version of street food, made to order and enjoyed in a crowd. After lunch, experience some of South Africa's finest craft gins and beers at Devils Peak Brewing Company. To end the day in style, shop for some of Africa's finest diamonds, tanzanite, and gems before being transported to dinner at Cape Town's newest food experience, the **4Roomed eKasi Culture**, where you will be treated to a feast of South African cultural dishes in South Africa's oldest township of Kayalitsha.

DAY 3

(Breakfast/Dinner)

After Breakfast, a ferry will transport you to Robben Island, where you will spend the morning learning more about Nelson Mandela's imprisonment at the hands of the Apartheid Government. The afternoon is spent at leisure along the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront, taking photos along the scenic boardwalk, shopping, or exploring the V&A market while enjoying lunch at one of its many great dining outlets. In the evening, you will be treated to dinner at one of the Top 10 Restaurants in the Cape.

DAY₄

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 4 focuses on wineries in the Hermel en Aarde (Heaven and Earth) region, which is famed for its Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Decanter Magazine once named the region's Pinot Noir as one of the best outside of Burgundy. Enjoy the wines at acclaimed wineries, such as Newton Johnson, Hamilton Russell Vineyards.

DAY 5

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 5 focuses on wineries in the Franschhoek and Stellenbosch region. The drive en route will present many scenic photographic opportunities with spectacular views of Theewaterskloof Dam, the famed fruit farming town of Villiersdorp, Chenin Blanc, and craft beers. View Franschhoek like you've never seen it before from the top of the mountain pass.Taste wines at acclaimed wineries Remhoogte, and Eikendal before dinner at Cuccina de Giovanni.



DAY 6

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 6 focuses on wineries that were accorded John Platter's highest accolades, **Raats(Winery of the year 2018**), **DeMorgenzon**, and **Jordan**. Enjoy lunch at **Jordan Restaurant** (by George Jardine) before exploring the historic university town of Stellenbosch at your leisure. At dinner, you will be treated to the finest South African red meat available at the highly rated **Fat Butcher** in Stellenbosch.

DAY 7

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Spend the morning understanding the diversity of Cape Town's culture in **Bo Kaap**. After lunch, the rest of the afternoon is spent at picture-perfect locations along **Camp's Bay**, **Signal Hill**, and **District 6**. The journey's farewell meal is presented in the Manor house at **Spier** and will be accompanied by their legendary wines.
